SANCTIONS/ASSOCIATIONS:

- An officially sanctioned show of the American Dairy Goat Association

RULES:

- All goats must be inspected upon arrival while unloading and before being penned in the barns. Please check with Tamara Cash before unloading.
- The rules and regulations of the Oklahoma State Fair® (OSF) and the rules of the American Dairy Goat Association will govern this show.
- Tattoos of all first place winners will be checked for verification. If tattoos do not match those on the registration papers, premium money will be forfeited.
- A registration or recordation certificate for any animal six months of age or older is required. The registration or recordation certificate or the stamped duplicate application showing the date received by the office is required for any animal under six months of age.
- The show official will not accept copies of the registration or recordation certificate or the stamped duplicate application. The document specified above as the requirement for that age animal to be shown must be presented to the Show Secretary before the judging shall begin.
- Proof of ownership shall be the name on the registration or recordation certificate or on the stamped duplicate application.
- Information obtained from the ADGA office via telephone, email, fax, etc will not be accepted in lieu of any of the documents specified above.
- The base date for computing the age of the animals is September 21/22, the date the animal is to be judged.
- In all classes, an exhibitor is the owner of the animal as evidenced by the name on the registration or recordation certificate or on the stamped duplicate application.
- All group classes of a breed must be made up of only those animals that have been shown in those individual classes of that breed in this show and must be entered on the official entry form.
- There will not be pre-show milk out. Each exhibitor is encouraged not to over udder their animals.
- Exhibitors are requested to be neatly and appropriately attired in white when showing their animals in the ring.
- There will be a junior 4-H and FFA show held within the Open show open to all youth under 18 years of age as of January 1st of the current year. All goats shown in the 4-H & FFA show must be registered in the 4-H/FFA member's name. The 4-H/FFA members will show in the Open show. After the judge has placed the class those not entered in 4-H/FFA will leave the ring and the 4-H/FFA members will hold their place so ribbons can be given to them and placing recorded in the book. Entries for the 4-H/FFA show will be made on a separate entry form with entry fees indicating they are 4-H/FFA members. Entry fees must be paid for the Open show as well.

OKLAHOMA STATE FAIR®

- There will be a Junior Grand Champion, Reserve Junior Grand Champion, Senior Grand Champion and Reserve Senior Grand Champion picked in each breed. A Herdsman Award will be given daily.
- Show order will be Showmanship, Senior Doe Show, and Junior Doe Show. The Junior and Senior shows are separately sanctioned.

- All accounts of owner must be in financial good standing to be eligible to enter the show ring. Any and all monies will be applied to entry and show fees before being applied to exhibitor admission tickets.

ENTRY INFORMATION:

- Payee's W-9 form must be included with entry.
- Substitutions can be made on existing entries in the Livestock Show Office by 6:00 PM the day before the show.

FEES:

- **Required**
 - \$20.00/per head per show (if postmarked by August 15)
 - \$40.00/per head per show (if postmarked after August 15 & by September 1)
 - \$60.00/per head per show (if postmarked after September 1 & by 6:00 PM the day before the show)
- **Additional**
 - Additional Tickets (pre-order for immediate family members) \$7.00 adult single day ticket, \$4.00 child single day ticket (ages 11-6) \$20.00 Season Ticket (for all 11 days) or an Exhibitor Ticket Bundle (4 single day tickets) for \$20.00 if postmarked by September 1, 2011. You also may purchase a Season Pass for \$25.00 good for all 11 days.
 - Exhibitor will receive an armband(s) per the scale in the Open & Junior General Livestock Rules.

Class:

Junior Doe Show:

01. Junior Kid born May 2011 – September 2011
02. Intermediate Kid born in April 2011
03. Senior Kid born in March 2011
04. Junior Yearling born December 2010 – February 2011
05. Senior Yearling under 24 months as of November 2009 (never having freshened)
06. Junior Grand Champion Doe
07. Reserve Junior Grand Champion Doe
08. Junior Get of Sire – to consist of three Junior Does, the get of one sire. Sire must be named. Exhibitor limited to one entry by the same buck.
09. Junior Produce of Dam – to consist of two Junior Does. The produce of one dam. Dam must be named. Exhibitor limited to one entry by the same dam.
10. Best Three Junior Females – to consist of three Junior Does, all bred and owned by one exhibitor. Exhibitor limited to one entry.
11. Best Junior Doe of Show – to be selected from the Grand Champions of each breed.
12. Dam and Produce – to consist of dam and her daughter, either Junior or Senior daughter. This is the only group class available in the 4-H & FFA show.

Senior Doe Show

13. Does, under 2 years, having freshened
14. Does, 2 years – under 3 years
15. Does, 3 years – under 4 years
16. Does, 4 years – under 5 years
17. Does, over 5 years
18. Senior Grand Champion Doe
19. Reserve Senior Grand Champion Doe
20. Champion Challenge – In this class does that are permanent champions challenge the Grand Champion for Best of Breed. **(There is an entry fee for this class as well as a payout.)**
21. Best Udder of Each Breed – Judge will pick one doe from each class to compete for this award.
22. Senior Produce of Dam – to consist of two senior does from the same dam. Dam must be named. One entry from each dam per exhibitor.
23. Senior Get of Sire – to consist of three does from the senior division. Sire must be named. One entry from each sire per exhibitor.
24. Senior Best Three Females – three does from the senior division, all bred and owned by exhibitor.
25. Senior Dairy Herd – four does from the senior division owned by exhibitor.
26. Best Senior Doe of Show – the best of each breed will compete for this.
27. Best Udder of the Show – the best of each breed will compete for this.
28. Premier Exhibitor – to the exhibitor in each breed winning the most money on 8 animals exhibited by exhibitor in the single class.
29. Premier Breeder – to the breeder in each breed having 8 animals winning the most money in single classes, including animals bred by him but exhibited by others.

Group Entry Instructions – enter group number and name of group. Put name of dam or sire in parenthesis behind the group name if applicable. Example “Division 1032, Group Class 22, Name – Senior Get of Sire (Jackson’s Knoll Larry)”.
