## NOTES:

- Heifers may be entered in the open show by paying entry fees.
- All entries must be registered and recorded by a recognized breed association in the name of the exhibitor and registration papers, recorded by the breed associations, in the name of the junior exhibitor, must be presented at the time of the show. Animals registered in the name of a partnership or firm will not be accepted. A statement from a civic organization that has given an animal to a 4-H or FFA member, and is holding the registration papers, will be sufficient to meet ownership requirements.
- A junior exhibitor may exhibit no more than two animals in each class.
- Dairy cattle exhibited by 4-H and FFA members in the junior division must be housed and cared for during the period of ownership in the state of Oklahoma.
- **Exhibitors must show in clean pressed jeans, clean shirt with collar and club emblem (4-H or FFA). 4-H and FFA jackets are acceptable but not required. T-shirts, tennis shoes, and headwear are not allowed.**
- All accounts of owner must be in financial good standing to be eligible to enter the show ring. Any and all monies will be applied to entry and show fees before being applied to exhibitor admission tickets.

  - Division 1074 – Junior Brown Swiss
  - Division 1075 – Junior Guernsey
  - Division 1076 – Junior Holstein

#### Theron Jones Memorial Supreme Champion Junior Dairy Show Female Award

The Supreme Champion Female of the Junior Dairy Show Award is presented, in recognition and remembrance of Theron Jones, to the 4-H or FFA member whose show animal is selected as the "best of breeds" in the Junior Dairy Show. Theron Jones exhibited at the Oklahoma State Fair® every year from 1936, with a barrow, to 2000, with his Jerseys. Theron bought his first Jerseys in 1943 and exhibited them locally and nationally through the year 2000. He began teaching Agriculture Education at Vanoss, Oklahoma in 1945, moved to Tuttle in 1948 and remained there until retirement, only to continue teaching on his farm, conducting tours for thousands of Oklahoma City children. These tours earned him a feature article in Orbit magazine. Theron was a friend to many and Grandpa to the hundreds of kids he helped through the years. In addition to teaching, Jones was also dedicated to service, holding the office of President, at one time or another, in the following organizations: Grady County Fair Board; Tuttle Lions Club; Oklahoma Purebred Dairy Cattle Association; Oklahoma Jersey Cattle Association and the Sooner State Dairy Show. He also served as an Oklahoma State Fair® Dairy Superintendent for 30-plus years, an elder in the Tuttle Church of Christ and on the Executive Board of the Oklahoma DHIA. The Supreme Champion Junior Show Award, sponsored by the Friends of Theron Jones, will be given annually. The winner will receive this permanent traveling plaque to be returned each year and a personal plaque to keep in recognition of this outstanding achievement.
