RULES:

- Must be a member of the Junior Beefmaster Breeders Association (JBBA).
- The owner must exhibit entries unless he or she owns two entries in the same class, whereupon another bona fide JBBA exhibitor may show one of the entries. In a pair's class, the owner must exhibit the cow.
- Original BBU Certificate of Breeding (not copies) on each animal shown, including any calf-at-side, must be presented to a representative of the show at the time of check in. Application for a BBU Certificate of Breeding on calves less than 30 days of age must be presented.
- All heifers must be registered with Beefmaster Breeders United as a purebred and out of a BBU-Certified Purebred dam, Second Cross dam or as otherwise stated in the BBU By-Laws.
- All heifers shall be inspected to ensure that all identification numbers and holding brands branded or tattooed on the animal and the description match identically with the BBU Certificate of Breeding.
- Any heifer that, in the opinion of the designated BBU official, would be a detriment to the breed shall be removed from the show, regardless of any prior classification. Examples would be heifers exhibiting signs of low fertility, genetic or physical defects.
- Any uncontrollable heifer will be dismissed from the ring at the discretion of the judge.
- Heifers that do not show the day of month of birth on their BBU Certificate of Breeding shall be considered to be born on the first day of that month.
- Animals shall be shown with their hair coats laying downward in a natural state that is flat to the entire body, which includes the legs as well as the tail. Furthermore, no animals shall be shown that have any foreign object(s) glued to or otherwise attached or its natural hair color altered in a manner so as to change its conformation or appearance.
- A class may be split at the discretion of the show official/coordinator. Every effort will be made to split the class on a monthly basis.
- Heifers two (2) years and older on the day shown whose calf has died cannot be shown.
- All heifers, two (2) years and older on the day of the show must be palpated safe in calf by a licensed veterinarian and so state on the health certificate, with the exception of heifers nursing their BBU registered natural calf-at-side (under 6 months of age), in which case the heifer may show open.
- **Exhibitors must show in clean pressed jeans, clean shirt with collar and club emblem (4-H or FFA). 4-H and FFA jackets are acceptable but not required. T-shirts, tennis shoes, and headwear are not allowed.**
- All accounts of owner must be in financial good standing to be eligible to enter the show ring. Any and all monies will be applied to entry and show fees before being applied to exhibitor admission tickets.

PREMIUM INFORMATION:

- Premiums will be paid in all classes except division and overall championship classes.
- Premium Scale: \$35, \$25, \$15, \$5

ENTRY INFORMATION:

- Owner's W-9 form must be included with entry.
- Entries can be made online or mailed in. Online entries close August 15. Credit Card payments only taken online.

FEES:

- **Required**
 - \$30.00 per head (if postmarked or entered online by August 15)
 - \$60.00 per head (if postmarked after August 15 & by September 1)
- **Additional**
 - Equipment permit - \$30.00
 - Additional Tickets (pre-order for immediate family members) \$7.00 adult single day ticket, \$4.00 child single day ticket (ages 11-6) or an Exhibitor Ticket Bundle (4 single day tickets) for \$20.00 if postmarked by September 1, 2011. Also may purchase Season Pass for \$25.00 good for all 11 days.
 - Exhibitor will receive an armband(s) with Junior Entry.

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- Exhibitor agrees to abide by all rules, regulations, specifications and requirements set out in the General Rules and Regulations section (found separate from this section) and any other said rules distributed by Oklahoma State Fair® (OSF) management.

Classes:

- Classes will be broken after arrival and check-in at the show.
- Heifers born after September 1, 2009 are eligible to show.
- There will be one bred and owned class at the conclusion of the Owned Show. To be eligible, heifers must have been exhibited in Owned Show.
