SANCTIONS/ASSOCIATIONS:

- This show is an ALSA approved show sponsored by the Oklahoma LAMA Association.

RULES:

- All rules governing the Livestock Department as well as the general rules and regulations governing the Oklahoma State Fair® (OSF) will apply in this department.
- Individual llama ALSA numbers must be noted on entry form.
- Exhibitors are not required to be a member of ALSA. Non ALSA members must pay a \$30.00 per ranch show fee at time of check in.
- **Copies of your entry form(s) and I.L.R. Registration papers must be mailed to Penny Thomas, 22352 S 4190 Rd, Claremore, OK 74019. There will be no check in without papers. NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- Youth Events: All youth between the ages of 8 – 18 as of January 1 of the calendar year may show in ALSA approved Youth Classes. (The youth division of 4 – 7 years does not receive ALSA points.) To qualify for Youth ALSA points, the youth (8 – 18) must be an ALSA member. Points go to the youth not the llamas. All youth age 8 and above must be members of ALSA. Non-members must pay \$15.00 per person.
- A llama can be entered either in Youth or Open Performance Classes (Novice or Advanced) not both. Youth must have written permission from a parent, project leader, 4-H advisor or FFA advisor to participate in the youth events.
- **Any llama used in a Youth class must be entered in the appropriate halter class OR costume class at the entry cost of \$25.00. Youth entries must be on a separate form.**
- For information about ALSA membership contact the llama show superintendent.
- All llamas must be registered with I.L.R. (The Registry). (Exceptions: Youth or Gelding classes.)
- All llamas, (in-state and out-of-state), must be accompanied by an official health certificate issued within 30 days of the arrival at the Oklahoma State Fair®. No blood tests required. Health papers will be checked upon entering the fairgrounds.
- Wool Divisions:
 - Light Wool – Minimal body wool, short neck wool with smooth legs
 - Light/Medium Wool – Moderate to long body wool, short to moderate neck wool, smooth to moderate leg wool
 - Heavy Wool – Abundant body and neck wool with minimal to abundant leg wool (Leg wool at least to knee and hock)
 - Suri – The fleece of a Suri llama should drape over the llama’s body forming a natural part along the spine. The fibers should be grouped into a well defined lock structure which is indicated by the many individual separate locks of fiber formed at the skin and carrying out to the ends of the individual locks which should be independent and consistent in size and degree of spiral throughout the neck and body.
- The date for determining the llama’s age is September 25, 2011.
- Handler attire should be conservative, neat and appropriate for the class. Shoes must be worn and be appropriate. (Open toe shoes, sandals, and bare feet will disqualify the exhibitor.)
- All accounts of owner must be in financial good standing to be eligible to enter the show ring. Any and all monies will be applied to entry and show fees before being applied to exhibitor admission tickets.

- Absolutely no class changes after September 23 unless made by judge. No exceptions.

- \$25.00 per class (if postmarked by August 15 or entered online)
- \$50.00 per class (if postmarked after August 15 & by September 1)
- \$75.00 per class (if postmarked after September 1 & by September 10)
- \$5.00 ALSA recording fee – per animal
- \$20.00 Exhibitor Admission Pack (2 armbands, good for only 2 individuals for up to 4 days)
- \$30.00 per stall (including tack stall)

- Additional Tickets (pre-order for immediate family members) \$7.00 adult single day ticket, \$4.00 child single day ticket (ages 11-6) or an Exhibitor Ticket Bundle (4 single day tickets) for \$20.00 if postmarked by September 1, 2010. Also may purchase Season Pass for \$25.00 good for all 11 days.
