RULES:

- Steers in this division must not exceed 1,000 pounds.
- There is no limit on the number of prospect steers that can be entered and shown by an exhibitor.
- A minimum number of five (5) head must be entered to constitute a breed; otherwise the animals will be shown in the AOB Classification.
- When making entries, online or mailed in, please indicate the breed. If no breed is listed, the steer will be classified AOB.
- Classes will be divided by weight, not to exceed 15 animals per class/per breed.
- Hair/wool coloring and adding materials (natural or man-made) to change the conformation or natural appearance will not be permitted. False switches will be permitted.
- Weigh back: The top 3 steers in each class will be weighed after judging prior to official placing, and may not have gained more than 5% of the weight listed on the official weight card.
- **Exhibitors must show in clean pressed jeans, clean shirt with collar and club emblem (4-H or FFA). 4-H and FFA jackets are acceptable but not required. T-shirts, tennis shoes, and headwear are not allowed.**
- All accounts of owner must be in financial good standing to be eligible to enter the show ring. Any and all monies will be applied to entry and show fees before being applied to exhibitor or admission tickets.

PREMIUM INFORMATION:

Class premiums based on the number in each class:

- 5 or less head - \$50, \$40
- 6-7 head - \$60, \$40, \$30
- 8-9 head - \$60, \$50, \$40, \$30
- 10-11 head - \$70, \$60, \$50, \$40, \$30
- 12 or more head - \$70, \$60, \$50, \$40, \$30, \$30

Division & Overall:

- Grand Champion Prospect Steer - \$2500
- Reserve Grand Champion Prospect Steer - \$1000
- Third Overall Prospect Steer - \$500
- Fourth Overall Prospect Steer - \$250

ENTRY INFORMATION:

- Entries can be made online or mailed in. Online entries close August 15. Credit Card payments can only be made online.

▪ **Required**

- \$35.00 per head (if postmarked or entered online by August 15)
- \$70.00 per head (if postmarked after August 15 & by September 1)

▪ **Additional**

- Equipment permit - \$30.00
- Additional Tickets (pre-order for immediate family members) \$7.00 adult single day ticket, \$4.00 child single day ticket (ages 11 – 6) or an Exhibitor Ticket Bundle (4 single day tickets) for \$20.00 if postmarked by September 1, 2011. Also may purchase Season Pass for \$25.00 good for all 11 days.
- Exhibitor will receive an armband(s) with Junior Entry.
