RULES:

- All heifers must be officially registered by the Red Angus Association of America and must be in the sole name of the exhibitor. Only registered Red Angus cattle in Category 1A (100%) and Category 1B (87% through 99%) will be eligible to show. This specifically excludes cattle in Category II and III. Category 1A and 1B will show together in the same classes.
- Heifers must be legibly tattooed and must comply with the rules of the Oklahoma State Fair® and the Red Angus Association of America.
- Heifers and registration papers are subject to inspection by the Superintendent or Association representatives.
- **Exhibitors must show in clean pressed jeans, clean shirt with collar and club emblem (4-H or FFA). 4-H and FFA jackets are acceptable but not required. T-shirts, tennis shoes, and headwear are not allowed.**
- All accounts of owner must be in financial good standing to be eligible to enter the show ring. Any and all monies will be applied to entry and show fees before being applied to exhibitor admission tickets.

PREMIUM INFORMATION:

- The Oklahoma Red Angus Association and the Oklahoma State Fair® (OSF) will offer premiums in this division jointly.
- The Associations portion of premiums will be paid directly by the Oklahoma State Fair®.
- Premiums will be paid in all classes except division and overall championship classes.
- Premium Scale: \$45, \$35, \$25, \$15, \$5

ENTRY INFORMATION:

- Owner's W-9 form must be included with entry.
- Entries can be made online or mailed in. Online entries close August 15. Credit Card payments only taken online.

FEES:

- **Required**
 - \$30.00 per head (if postmarked by August 15)
 - \$60.00 per head (if postmarked after August 15 & by September 1)
- **Additional**
 - Equipment permit - \$30.00
 - Additional Tickets (pre-order for immediate family members) \$7.00 adult single day ticket, \$4.00 child single day ticket (ages 11 – 6) or an Exhibitor Ticket Bundle (4 single day tickets) for \$20.00 if postmarked by September 1, 2011. Also may purchase Season Pass for \$25.00 good for all 11 days.
 - Exhibitor will receive an armband(s) with Junior Entry.

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- Exhibitor agrees to abide by all rules, regulations, specifications and requirements set out in the General Rules and Regulations section (found separate from this section) and any other said rules distributed by OSF management.

Classes:

- Classes will be broken after arrival and check-in at the show by the breed superintendent (Cody McMurphy 405 880-4587).
- Heifers born on or after September 1, 2009, but no later than May 15, 2011 are eligible to show.
- There will be one bred and owned class at the conclusion of the Owned Show. To be eligible, heifers must have been exhibited in Owned Show.
