The American Shorthorn Association (ASA), Dr. Bert Moore, Executive Secretary, 8288 Hascall Street, Omaha, NE 68124, will pay open show exhibitors an additional 20% of each individual premium paid by the Oklahoma State Fair® (OSF) amounting to \$10.00 or more. No exhibitor will be paid more than two premiums in an individual class, and the Association does not pay additional premiums in the championship classes. The ASA's share of the premiums will be handled as account credits directly through their office in Omaha, Nebraska.

RULES:

- All cattle must be purebred to be eligible to show.
- In order for an exhibitor to be eligible to receive the American Shorthorn Association's (ASA) share of the premiums at an ASA supported show, the owner's entire herd must be enrolled in the Shorthorn Performance Records (SPR) Program and each animal shown must have individual SPR records.
- No exhibitor shall be permitted to win more than two prizes in any one class.
- Individual animals shown in all of the group classes listed below must have been entered and shown in one of the following classes for single animals. Multiple owned animals must be exhibited in the names of all owners.
- Family bred and raised animals entered by juniors in Junior Classes and subsequently entered in Open Classes may be treated as family entries in group classes. Group classes need to be pre-entered.
- All Shorthorns and Polled Shorthorns are subject to a tattoo inspection by representatives of the ASA. All Shorthorn and Polled Shorthorn are also subject to an age inspection if deemed necessary by the ASA and the decision of the examining veterinarian is final. Use of artificial fins on show animals is not permitted.
- **Senior/Junior Yearling Pregnancy Rule for exhibitors at all Open shows:** Any senior/junior yearling female 28 months of age or older on or before the date of the show must have a natural calf at side and must be shown with such. All females 20 months of age on or before the date of the show must have a 60 day pregnancy verification signed by an accredited, non-owner veterinarian at the time the female is processed for the show. If verification cannot be produced, the female may be allowed to participate if the exhibitor can produce a qualified veterinarian to examine the female at the show site, and verify a 60-day pregnancy. Any infractions against this rule will lead to disqualification of that animal for that specific show.
- All accounts of owner must be in financial good standing to be eligible to enter the show ring. Any and all monies will be applied to entry and show fees before being applied to exhibitor admission tickets.

PREMIUM INFORMATION:

- Premiums will be paid in all classes except division and overall championship classes.
- Individual Class Premiums: \$65, \$45, \$35, \$20, \$10
- Group Class Premiums: \$40, \$30, \$20

ENTRY INFORMATION:

- Owner's W-9 form must be included with entry.
- Entries can be made online or mailed in. Online entries close August 16. Credit Card payments can only be made online.

- Substitutions can be made on existing entries for \$10.00 per sub and must be made in the Livestock Show Office by 4:00 PM the day before the show.

FEES:

- **Required**
 - \$35.00 per head (if postmarked or entered online by August 15)
 - \$70.00 per head (if postmarked after August 15 & by September 1)
 - \$105.00 per head (if postmarked after September 1 & by 4:00 PM the day before the show)
- **Additional**
 - Equipment permit - \$30.00
 - Additional Tickets (pre-order for immediate family members) \$7.00 adult single day ticket, \$4.00 child single day ticket (ages 11-6) or an Exhibitor Ticket Bundle (4 single day tickets) for \$20.00 if postmarked by September 1, 2011. You may also purchase a Season Pass for \$25.00 good for all 11 days.
 - Exhibitor will receive an armband(s) per the scale in the Open & Junior General Livestock Rules.

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- Exhibitor agrees to abide by all rules, regulations, specifications and requirements set out in the General Rules and Regulations section and any other said rules distributed by OSF management.

IMPORTANT: Each of the following classes **MAY** be broken into multiple classes to accommodate large numbers of entries, but separate classes **may NOT** be combined into one. For example, there **MAY** be four "Junior Heifer Calf" classes, but there **may NOT** be one single "Spring Heifer Calf" class (combining Late and Early Spring calves).

Class:

Females

01. Late spring heifer calves calved after May 1, 2011
02. Early spring heifer calves calved between March 1 and April 30, 2011
03. Junior heifer calves calved between January 1 and February 28, 2011
04. **Junior Heifer Calf Champion** - chosen from 1st place winners in classes 1, 2, & 3
05. **Junior Heifer Calf Reserve Champion** – chosen from 1st & 2nd place winners in classes 1, 2, & 3
06. Winter heifer calves calved between November 1 and December 31, 2010
07. Senior heifer calves calved between September 1 and October 31, 2010
08. **Senior Heifer Calf Champion** – chosen from 1st place winners in classes 6 & 7
09. **Senior Heifer Calf Reserve Champion** – chosen from 1st & 2nd place winners in classes 6 & 7
10. Summer yearling females calved between July 1 and August 31, 2010
11. Late spring yearling females calved between May 1 and June 30, 2010
12. **Intermediate Champion Female** – chosen from 1st place winners in classes 10 & 11
13. **Reserve Intermediate Champion Female** – chosen from the 1st & 2nd place winners in classes 10 & 11
14. Early Spring Yearling Females – calved between March 1 and April 30, 2010
15. **Junior Champion Female** – chosen from 1st place winner from class 14
16. **Reserve Junior Champion Female** – chosen from 1st and 2nd place winners from class 14
17. Junior yearling females calved between January 1 and February 29, 2010
18. Senior yearling females calved between September 1 and December 31, 2009
19. **Senior Champion Female** – chosen from the first place winners in classes 17 & 18
20. **Reserve Senior Champion Female** – chosen from the 1st & 2nd place winners in classes 17 & 18
21. **Grand Champion Female** – chosen from Junior Calf, Senior Calf, Junior, and Senior Champion Females
22. **Reserve Grand Champion Female** - chosen from Junior Calf, Senior Calf, Junior, and Senior Champion and Reserve Champion Females
23. Group of two females – bred and owned or co-owned by breeder (exhibitor)

Bulls

24. Late spring bull calves calved after May 1, 2011
25. Early spring bull calves calved between March 1 and April 30, 2011
26. Junior bull calves calved between January 1 and February 28, 2011
27. **Junior Bull Calf Champion** – chosen from 1st place winners in classes 24, 25, & 26

28. **Reserve Junior Bull Calf Champion** – chosen from the 1st & 2nd place winners in classes 24, 25, and 26
29. Winter bull calves calved between November 1 and December 31, 2010
30. Senior bull calves calved between September 1 and October 31, 2010
31. **Senior Bull Calf Champion** – chosen from the 1st place winners in classes 29 & 30
32. **Senior Bull Calf Reserve Champion** – chosen from 1st & 2nd place winners in classes 29 & 30
33. Summer yearling bulls calved between July 1 and August 31, 2010
34. Late spring yearling bulls calved between May 1 and June 30, 2010
35. **Intermediate Champion Bull** – Chosen from 1st place winners from classes 33 & 34
36. **Reserve Intermediate Champion Bull** – chosen from 1st and 2nd place winners in classes 33 & 34
37. Early spring yearling bulls calved between March 1 and April 30, 2010
38. Junior yearling bulls calved between January 1 and February 29, 2010
39. **Junior Champion Bull** – chosen from 1st place winners in classes 37 & 38
40. **Reserve Junior Champion Bull** – chosen from 1st & 2nd place winners in classes 37 & 38
41. Senior yearling bulls calved between July 1 and December 31, 2009
42. Two year old bulls calved between January 1 and June 30, 2009
43. **Senior Champion Bull** – chosen from 1st place winners in classes 41 & 42
44. **Reserve Senior Champion Bull** – chosen from 1st & 2nd place winners in classes 41 & 42
45. **Grand Champion Bull** – chosen from Junior Calf, Senior Calf, Junior, and Senior Champion Bulls
46. **Reserve Grand Champion** - chosen from Junior Calf, Senior Calf, Junior, and Senior Reserve Champion Bulls

Groups

47. Group of two bulls – **Bred and owned or co-owned** by the breeder (exhibitor)
48. Super Cow class – Class should consist of two (2) offspring of **either or same** sex of show age classification. Offspring **do not** need owned by the same exhibitor. No more than one pair from each cow can win a prize in the class.
49. Get-of-Sire class – class should consist of four offspring of **either or same** sex of any age from the same sire. Offspring **do not** need to be owned by the same exhibitor. No more than one group from each sire can win a prize in this class.
50. Best six head – **Owned or co-owned** by exhibitor.
