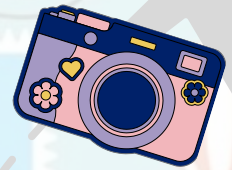

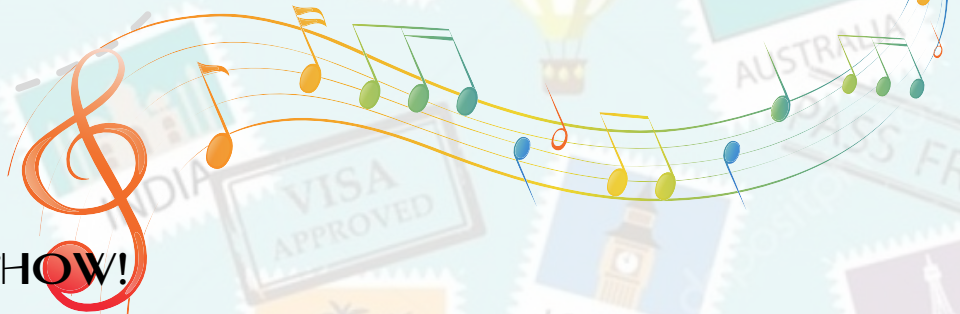


KARAOKE CONTEST

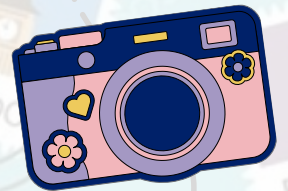
