022.1: Friesian Baroque in Hand: Purebred Mares022.2: Friesian Baroque in Hand: Purebred Geldings

026.1: Sport Horse In Hand – Purebred Friesian Mares026.2: Sport Horse in Hand – Purebred Friesian Geldings

It will be up to each exhibitor entered in the original combined classes 014, 022 and 026 to be aware of the class their horse will now go in.

The class order for Friday, September 20:

Starting 8 a.m.

Classes # 001 through class 022 (022.1 and 022.2) will run as originally scheduled

Class # 043: Championship: Purebred Friesians in Hand will be held following class 022 Resuming with classes numbered 023, 024, 025 and 026.

Class # 044: Sport Horse in Hand: Part Bred Friesians will follow class 26 above.

After classes 022 will be class 043 then 023, 024, 025 and 026.


Then class 44 will follow class 026.


