

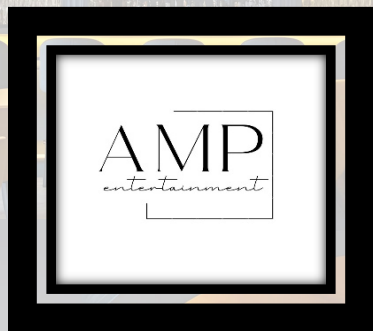
THE LOUNGE

Oklahoma Swing

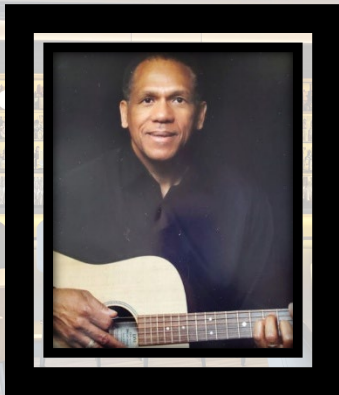
Wed 9/17: 3:30, 6, & 8:30 p.m.

Sat 9/20: 3:30, 6:30, & 9:30 p.m.

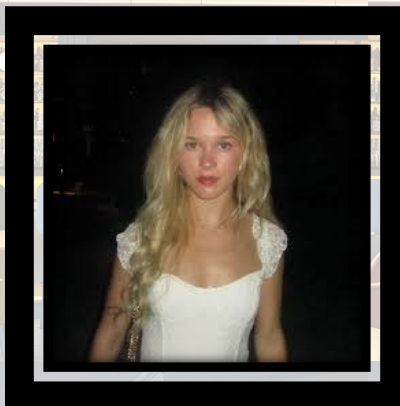
