



ARRIVAL & ENTRANCE INSTRUCTIONS

4-H/FFA Livestock & Dairy Judging Contests

ARRIVAL/PARKING

If you are pre-registered, you will be emailed a temporary, Gate 8 Passenger Vehicle Access Pass before September 15.

Print this pass and be ready to show this credential to our parking/gate attendants - this will allow complimentary parking for arrival between 7 – 10 a.m. ONLY.

HOW TO ENTER THE FAIRGROUNDS

- Enter OKC Fairgrounds from Portland Avenue on the south side of OKC Fairgrounds. Follow the directions indicated on the “Fairgrounds Map” found on the following page.
- Do not attempt to enter the barn complex if you are not transporting animals.
- If you have not filled out the appropriate pre-registration form by the deadline indicated in this document, you will be required to pay for parking.
 - To pay for parking on site – you will be required to approach the indicated parking lot from off of NW 10th Street.

ADMISSION THROUGH GATE 8

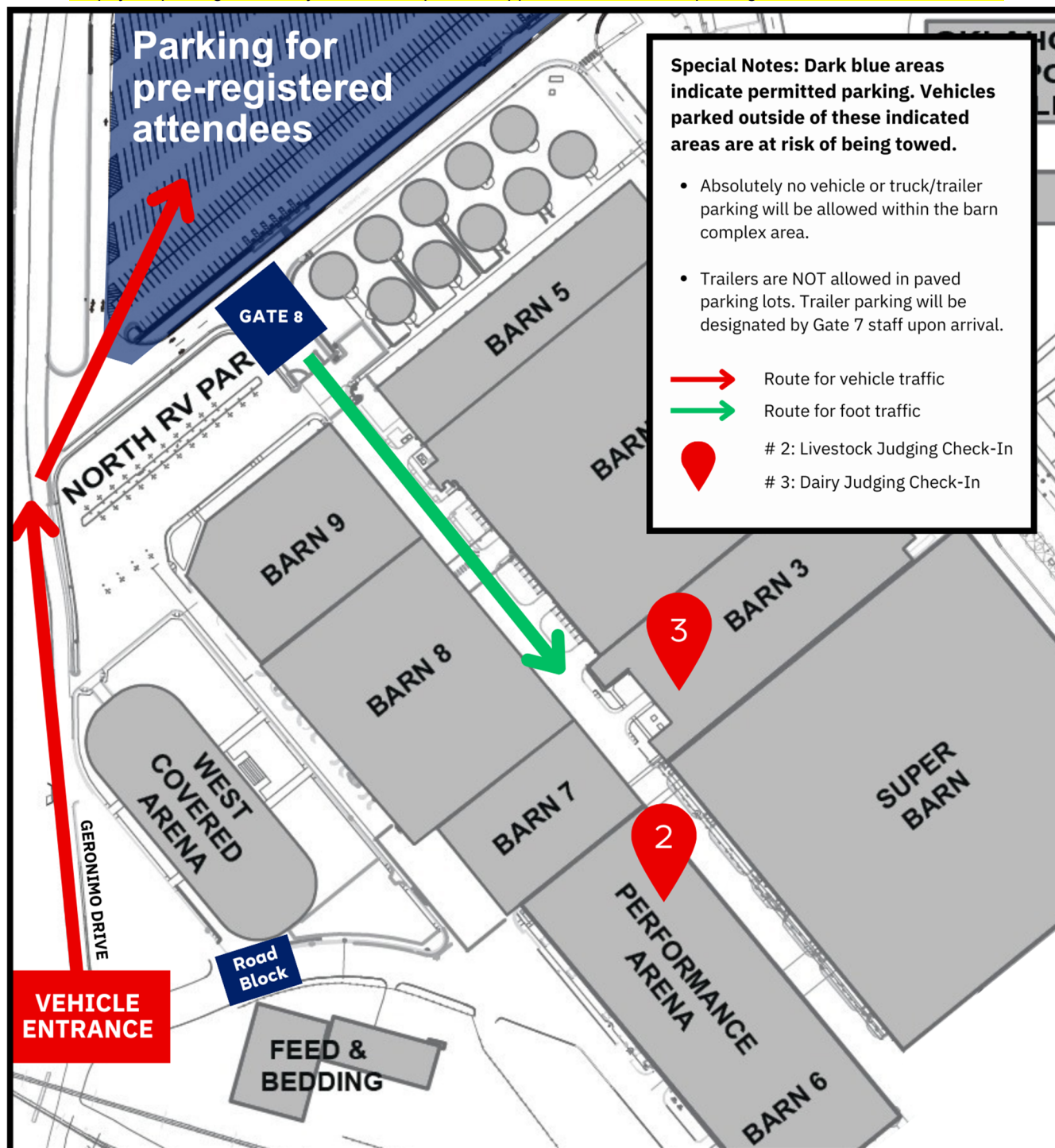
- After parking passenger vehicles in the Gate 8 parking lot, north of the barn complex, walk to Gate 8. Gate attendants will admit all pre-registered/eligible contestants, ag instructors/leaders, or chaperones. Complimentary gate admission will be allowed for preregistered individuals that arrive between the hours of 7 – 10 a.m.
- Individuals who did not pre-register will need to purchase parking and Fair admission.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION AND GUIDELINES

- The contest will consist of judging market beef, sheep, swine and/or breeding classes.
- Each contestant will answer at least one (1) set of questions in a class.
- There will be 10 questions - each question will be worth 5 points.
- Oral reasons will not be given.
- Contestants should bring pencils.

CONTESTANT ELIGIBILITY

FFA Members: Any student in grades 8-12 must be regularly enrolled in a year-long course of study in agricultural education at school in order to be eligible to participate in any FFA activity. Students in the seventh grade are not eligible for FFA membership in Oklahoma.

4-H Members: Any Oklahoma member who is 8 years old and in the third grade through age 19 as of September 1.

Teams:

- A team will consist of three (3) to four (4) members from the same FFA chapter or 4-H county.
- There are no limitations on the number of teams from a chapter/county.

Team Classifications:

- Junior 4-H Teams: Grades 3 – 7
- Senior 4-H Teams: Grades 8 – 12
- Junior FFA Teams: Grades 8 – 10
- Senior FFA Teams: Grades 11 – 12

CONTESTANT ELIGIBILITY

FFA Members: Any student in grades 8-12 must be regularly enrolled in a year-long course of study in agricultural education at school in order to be eligible to participate in any FFA activity. Students in the seventh grade are not eligible for FFA membership in Oklahoma.

4-H Members: Any Oklahoma member who is 8 years old and in the third grade through age 19 as of September 1.

Teams:

- A team will consist of three (3) to four (4) members from the same FFA chapter or 4-H county.
- There are no limitations on the number of teams from a chapter/county.

AWARDS

Individual Classes:

- The top 10 students will be awarded ribbons.
- 1st – 3rd Place individuals will receive a medallion.

Team Classes:

- The top 10 FFA teams will be awarded ribbons.
- The top 5 4-H teams will be awarded ribbons.
- 1st – 3rd place teams will receive a plaque.
- All team members, on each of the 1st – 3rd place teams, will receive a medallion.
