

2025 Learning Centers

State Fair Academy (Academy) learning centers are devoted areas that provide learning opportunities for Academy participants. Some learning centers are set up exclusively during the Fair for the Academy. Others are regular Fair exhibits that are volunteering additional shows and special presentations outside of their normal performances, especially for the Academy. Please be sure to thank these presenters!

SCHEDULING YOUR LEARNING CENTER STOPS *

- Groups will not be able to attend all the learning centers on one trip. There are a variety of opportunities at various times and locations so groups can choose from a wide selection.
- ➤ Each group should plan to attend a minimum of three official Academy learning centers during their field trip. If time permits, groups are welcome to attend additional venues.
- Some give short, educational demos at specific show times. Others are ongoing and designed to allow groups to stop by at any time during the Academy hours.

Be sure that choices of activities are available on the days your group has scheduled your Academy tour. It is important to note that the times for each learning center vary!

YOUR FIRST STOP - ACADEMY CHECK-IN 🏞

Check-in Tent – Location: Gate 5 (see map).

This is everyone's required first stop, you will receive the items below at check in.

- Chaperone tickets you will receive 1 for every 4 children.
- Academy daily schedule of events and additional maps.
- Your scheduled Ag in the Classroom time.

After checking in, greeters will direct groups to the lunch storage tent to deposit coolers and boxes for storage.

Lunch Storage Tent – Location: Bandshell Lawn

A Fair volunteer will lead your group through the Admission Gate and direct you to the Lunch Tent. You can drop your coolers, boxes, etc. on and below the tables. If your group did not bring lunch, they will still be directed here as a starting point for your tour. Reminder to pickup your items before leaving. Any unclaimed items will be discarded.

The City of AGtropolis is home to all kinds of barnyard animals—including goats, chickens, pigs, rabbits, and even bugs! Take a stroll through the city streets to see baby chicks hatching, goats climbing, rabbits hopping, and how goat milk is turned into useful products. You'll also get to explore how honey is made and watch bugs doing what bugs do best!

Southwest Dairy

Ever wonder how your milk gets from a dairy farm to your table? Learn what goes into the dairy products used in your everyday life. Watch a cow get milked, ask all your burning questions about the life of a dairy farmer and learn some great facts about milk!

Honeybee Haven

HEREFORD DYSTOCIA Simulator

Come see something really cool, thanks to the Oklahoma State University Extension Service! It's called the Hereford Dystocia Simulator—a pretend cow that shows how a baby calf is born. You'll get to watch how the calf comes out and learn why it can sometimes be hard. There's also a fun sign that shows where your favorite foods like steak and hamburgers come from on the cow.
