# **ACCESSIBILITY GUIDE**

**2025**

**This guide is intended to provide useful and easy to find information about services and activities for guests with a variety of needs during the State Fair.**

## **ARRIVAL TO OKC FAIR PARK**

Please note that due to bridge construction on NW 10th Street between May Avenue and I-44, delays should be expected. Arrival to the State Fair, especially regarding ticketed or timed events, should be planned accordingly.

## **PARKING**

There are acres and acres of free and paid parking. Paid parking is \$15, no come and go, and is **100% CASHLESS!** A credit or debit card must be used. Apple, Google, and other “card not present” method of payments are not accepted currently. A 3% processing fee will be added to each transaction. The best FREE ADA parking is located at Gate 6 (off Reno Avenue) / Del Mar Gardens. Just show a valid placard or license plate to the parking attendant and fairgoers may skip the paid parking fee and park in this lot while spaces are available. **See map on back cover for locations.**

## **RENTALS**

Privately owned, electric “single rider,” mobility scooters or wheelchairs are welcome. Those who prefer to rent these items can do so from Vista Mobility. Reservations are encouraged at [vistamobility.net](http://vistamobility.net). Three locations will operate during the State Fair: on The Circle near Gate 2, on the southwest side of the OG&E Coliseum near Gate 6, and behind the Oklahoma Expo Hall near Gate 9.

## **COMFORT & SAFETY**

### **RESTROOMS**

OKC Fair Park has family restrooms located in many buildings. Momentum Refresh will also be on site. This specialty vehicle is a unique universal design mobile restroom. Located on The Circle, in front of the Modern Living Building, it is manned by trained personnel who will assist guests and clean between visits. In addition to the fully adjustable and accessible restroom equipment developed for both children and adults, this vehicle will have dedicated space for families who need a place for calming or nursing.

### **CALMING SPACES**

Three unique locations will be available this year: the Arts Annex, Momentum Refresh, and near Gate 9. These spaces are available for guests who need a break from the hustle and bustle of the Fair, such as those on the autism spectrum or who have sensory processing challenges.

### **NURSING SPACES**

Families who need this space can find a room in the lobby of the Bennett Event Center or at the Momentum Refresh Trailer.

### **PRIORITY SEATING REST STOPS**

There are a multitude of seating options for resting, eating, and watching entertainment throughout the grounds. Additionally, Accessibility Priority Seating Rest Stops have been created for individuals who need a rest break as they make their way around the grounds. Each of these five locations has two benches and a large, multi-color paneled umbrella marking the spot. Signage at these short-term rest stops will be visible, reminding everyone of the purpose.

## **SAFETY and LOST & FOUND**

Emergency and security personnel can be found throughout the grounds. Anyone needing security or medical assistance can request aid at the InFAIRmation booths or at the Safety Center, located in the Administration Building on General Pershing Blvd. If separated from their group, lost persons will be escorted to the Safety Center by State Fair security to be reunited with their party. Lost items can be found there as well. To aid in the reunification of group members, fairgoers are encouraged to get a FREE Project Unite armband from one of the InFAIRmation booths upon arrival at the fair. This band will assist security personnel in getting family and friends back together even faster.

## **SPECIAL EVENTS & ACTIVITIES**

### **OG&E COLISEUM EVENTS**

Visitors can expect the best from this brand-new venue. It will be open for attendees of Disney On Ice, Trace Adkins & Casey Donahew in concert, and the Wildcatters PBR Teams Challenge. The building is equipped with a family restroom with adult-size changing equipment. A variety of ADA seating areas are available. ## **SENIOR DAY and SENIOR DAY SHUTTLE**

### **Wednesday, September 17**

Senior Day welcomes those 55 years and older (I.D. may be required) with **FREE** outside gate admission and **\$5** Sky Eye Wheel rides. Seniors can enjoy special activities in the Modern Living Building throughout the day and everyone's favorite Elvis impersonator, Shawn Klush, will perform on the Chickasaw Country Entertainment Stage that evening. Check the website for specific events and times.

**New this year and ONLY ON SENIOR DAY** – the Oklahoma State Fair and EMBARK will provide a **FREE** senior shuttle from Hurricane Harbor on Reno Avenue straight to State Fair Gate 3 and back again. Parking spaces at Hurricane Harbor are limited, this service is first-come-first-served. Buses run every 15 minutes from **9 a.m.** to **9:45 p.m.**

## **SENSORY-FRIENDLY TIME**

### **Sunday, September 21, 10 a.m. – 2 p.m.**

Sensory-Friendly Time will feature special activities and ways for guests to enjoy their visit in a less noisy and less bright atmosphere. An informational guide and a social narrative are available on the State Fair's website under "accessibility."

## **ACCESSIBILITY EXPO**

### **Sunday, September 21, noon – 6 p.m.**

Oklahoma State Fair and Square Holes are proud to present the first-ever Accessibility Expo at the Oklahoma State Fair. Located in the Modern Living Building, it will be a celebration of inclusion, innovation, and community. This exciting new event brings together organizations, artists, vendors, and advocates working to support and empower disabled Oklahomans and their families. The public is welcome at the Expo – attendance is **free** with Fair admission.
