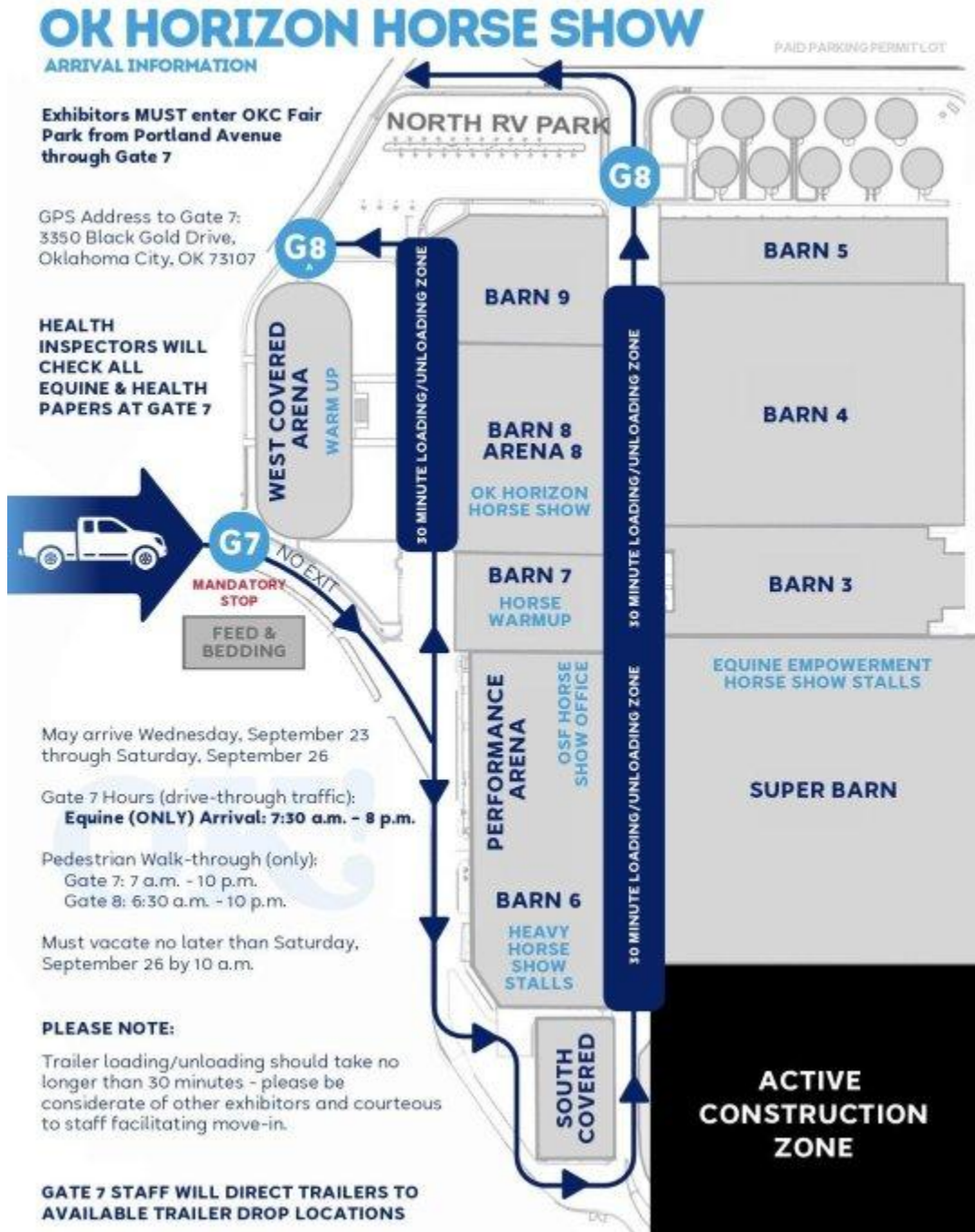

Entries : Entries close September 1st, 2026 and must be postmarked by that date.. The entry office will close one hour before each session.

Open Checks : The Horse Show requires a signed open check be left with the entry office for all tab accounts. No back numbers will be issued without an open check. It is the responsibility of each exhibitor or agent to settle his/her account by the end of the show. Upon failure to do so, the horse show secretary will fill in the correct amount on the open check and the exhibitor or agent relinquishes the right for adjustment after leaving the show.

Stalls and Stall Reservations : Stalls and tack stalls are \$90.00 each. Stalls will be available on Wednesday, September 23, 2026 7:30 AM

Arrival Specifications : Exhibitors and horses involved in this Event will be allowed to arrive starting Wednesday, September 23 at 7:30 a.m. Animals with the required health papers will be received only through the designated gate and during the hours of 7:30 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Animals will be denied access to the facilities outside of these hours or if unable to provide all health documents as required.

Move Out : All horses and tacks stalls must be vacated by 10:00 AM Saturday, September 26th 2026

Stall Assignment Policy : Stalls will be assigned by the show management to most efficiently use available stalls.

Returned Checks: All returned checks will be charged a \$50.00 returned check fee.

Bedding: Bedding will need to be ordered through the OKC Fair Park Feed Store.

<https://okcfab.company.site/> No outside bedding allowed.

Exhibitor Admission : An admission ticket is required for each day's entry whether move-in, show day, or move-out. \$8/ticket. Re-entry with a ticket stub and that day's handstamp is allowed within each day.

Parking : Parking will be provided at not more than one pass per Exhibitor for \$30. A parking pass will grant access to any public paid parking lot for the duration of Oklahoma Horizon Horse Show. Passes beyond one per exhibitor will be at the rate of \$75.

BUY-A-CLASS Buy-A-Class opportunities are being offered for the purchase price of \$85.00. All Buy-A-Classes must be chosen as soon as possible so that exhibitors may be notified that we are offering the classes. Simply request any class or Stake class (which has a qualifying class) that you would like to have at the horse show. These are offered on a first come basis and must be paid for in advance. Please contact Amanda Hawley at 405-639-7655 to arrange to purchase a Buy-A-Class. Buy-A-Classes will not count as qualifying classes for the World's Championship Horse Show.

No Canter Classes: Riders showing in a no canter class cannot cross enter in a canter class except in the English Pleasure Walk and Trot--Open (Saddle Seat/Hunter Seat) (Any Breed) class.

Junior Exhibitor Classes: Open to junior exhibitor riders that are 17-years-old and under.

Junior Horse Classes: Open to horses that are four-years-old and under.

Adult Amateur Classes: Open to adult amateur riders that are 18-years-old and over.

Warm-Up Ring Procedure: The next class on the schedule has priority for the use of the warm-up ring.

Ring Procedure: The gate to the show ring will be closed two minutes after the first horse enters the ring. Any exhibitor not in the ring by that time will not be admitted. Due to unforeseen problems with any

mechanical device, the PA system and paddock calls over that system must be considered a courtesy. Therefore no protest will be upheld, nor will any section be changed due to a **PA malfunction**.

Proper Attire: All riders, drivers, and attendants must be neatly and appropriately dressed when entering the ring.

Stable Area: Gas, electric or propane heaters, propane tanks, hot plates, and air conditioners are prohibited in the stable area. All electrical extension cords must be 12 gauge, 3 wire, and prong negative type.

Attention Getting Devices: Items such as tape measures, blow horns, split bamboo poles, whistles, aerosol cans, or whips longer than six feet that would alter the performance of a horse or disturb another horse will not be allowed at the entrance of the show ring, ring side, or in the warm-up ring. Explosives, fire extinguishers, and laser light beams are prohibited on the show grounds before, during, and after the show. All such items will be confiscated.

Trailer and Vehicle Parking: All trailers and vehicles must be parked in designated areas. Absolutely no trailer or vehicle parking will be permitted in the barn area. The fire code dictates that fire lanes must be left open on all sides of the barns in case of emergency.

Pets: All pets on the grounds must be on a leash and under control at all times.

Exhibitors: Please assist in maintaining clean facilities and grounds by placing litter in trash receptacles. Please place manure and used shavings from the stalls and trailers in designated areas. Do not turn horses loose in any ring on the show grounds

Discipline: Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judge or officials, on the part of the owner, manager, rider, driver, or groom shall be grounds to disqualify the horse, and the owner shall forfeit all fees. In the case of any horse being disqualified, the winner of the next succeeding prize in that class shall take the prize that had been awarded to the disqualified horse.

Protest: If you wish to file a protest, please see horse show management (whose decision shall be final). There will be a charge of \$100.00 until the protest is resolved. If the protest is in your favor, you will be refunded the \$100.00. If the protest is not in your favor, you forfeit the \$100.00. The horse that is being protested may be asked for registration papers.

Show Committee: The Show Committee reserves the right to decline to receive any entry and to return any entry fee and/or stall fee before or during the show, without being liable for compensation. Should any questions arise that are not provided for in the foregoing rules, the same shall be referred to the show committee whose decision shall be final.

Liability: The Oklahoma Horizon Horse Show and the OKCFP will not be responsible for any accident, theft, damage, or injury occurring at the facility. The show committee of the Oklahoma Horizon Horse Show, the OKCFP, the Equine Sports Council, nor any volunteer or sponsor will be responsible for any accident which may occur to any owner, vendor, spectator, driver, rider, groom, attendant, animal, or equipment at the show. Each rider exhibits at their own risk.

Equine Sports Council Rules: The Oklahoma Horizon Horse Show will be governed by the Equine Sports Council. A copy of the most current rulebook is available at equinesportscouncil.org.

The undersigned is participating in an event (Oklahoma Horizon Horse Show) at the Oklahoma State Fair with dates including September 23, 2026 to September 26, 2026 (the "Event"). In consideration for the right to participate in the Event, the undersigned, on his/her/its behalf and on behalf of his/her/its heirs, executors, administrators, next of kin, successors, affiliates, and assigns, all of whom shall be legally bound by this release and waiver, hereby knowingly, intentionally, purposively, freely, voluntarily and without duress agree as follows:

The undersigned acknowledges and understands that (i) participating in the Event is voluntary and solely for his/her/its own benefit, (ii) the undersigned is familiar with the risks and liabilities associated with the Event. The undersigned is **prepared to, and does, hereby accept any and all risks, whether known or unknown, which may arise directly or indirectly from the Event.**

The undersigned forever discharges the Indemnified Parties (defined below) from any claims that the undersigned may have against the Indemnified Parties including, without limitation, claims with respect to any bodily injury, personal injury, illness, death or property damage or loss that he/she/it may sustain as a direct or indirect result of (i) the Indemnified Parties' negligence (whether active or passive), (ii) his/her/it participating in the Event and/or (iii) any and all risks assumed by him/her/it hereunder, including any claim resulting of and from all manner of action or actions, cause or causes of action, suits, claims, demands, damages, and liability, lost cost or expense of any nature whatsoever, whether at law, in equity, or otherwise, known or unknown, fixed or contingent which he/she/it may have or hereafter have against the Indemnified Parties.

The undersigned is aware of and understands Oklahoma Statutes, Section 50 of Title 76 pertaining to the Oklahoma Livestock Liability Limitations Act. The person submitting this, along with any entry, therein agrees to accept authority to act as agent for actual and/or recorded owner(s) of any/all animal(s) being entered, if applicable, and, in doing so, indicates acceptance of all rules, regulations, liability limitations for all individuals so named as owner, trainer, agent, exhibitor, rider, handler, groom, guest and/or showman.

This release and waiver shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Oklahoma.

In the event that any provision of this release and waiver shall be held invalid, illegal or unenforceable under applicable law, the remainder of this release and waiver shall remain valid and enforceable.
