

Frequently Asked Questions

How do we get there?

OKC Fair Park is located near the I-40 & I-44 junction in Oklahoma City. It is bordered on the east by May Avenue and on the north by N.W. 10th Street.

Teachers will receive colored parking passes for registered buses and vehicles to be placed in the front window(s). Parking passes must be placed in windows prior to entering Gate 5 so parking attendants can identify the registered vehicles.

Buses and registered vehicles will enter Gate 5 from May Avenue and be directed to specific parking for unloading.

How long does the trip last?

State Fair Academy is set up to allow groups to attend a variety of learning centers. Most groups find they need about four (4) hours to arrive, be oriented, attend three (3) learning centers, have lunch and load up to depart.

Although Academy officially ends at 2:30 p.m., groups are welcome to stay later to attend additional exhibits and attractions.

Where do unregistered vehicles park?

Free parking is available in designated lots. Vehicles wishing to park with the buses will need to follow the attendants' instructions to the \$15 paid parking lot.

How do we get parking passes?

A specific number of free parking passes are issued based on registration. Parking passes will be mailed to the school/group after we have confirmed the trip.

How many admissions passes do we receive?

Students registered through schools for Academy do not need admission passes.

Teachers/chaperones will receive one (1) admission pass for every four (4) students. Passes will be distributed at check-in and collected at the gate. For up to date pricing please see our [Plan Your Visit page](#).

What's the schedule?

That's up to you! The Learning Centers Schedule provides details on times and locations for several exhibits that may interest you and your students. You have the flexibility to pick and choose what works best for your group!

What are learning centers?

On specific days during the Oklahoma State Fair, several exhibits are transformed into special learning centers. These historical, educational and fun learning centers are created specially to provide various learning opportunities for the groups, while helping schools achieve Oklahoma Academic Standards.

Can we bring outside food and drink?

Groups are allowed to bring sack lunches, and it is highly recommended to bring bottled water for the students. Any drinks or drink containers must be in your coolers or boxes when you arrive. We recommend that you bring a small handcart to transport lunches and drinks to the lunch tent or have the chaperones carry them in. State Fair volunteers will not be responsible for transporting food and drinks.

Where do we store our lunches?

A special Academy lunch storage tent is set up on the Bandshell Lawn. State Fair volunteers will escort groups to the tent. All coolers/boxes must be clearly marked.

Can we leave our coolers/boxes in the tent after we eat?

The lunch storage tent is not monitored, but you are welcome to store your items in the tent until you leave for the day. All items not picked up will be discarded at the end of the Fair day.

Is bus funding available?

No, bus funding is no longer available.

What if we have to cancel?

If for some reason a reservation must be cancelled, please notify us at 405-948-6729.

Can I reschedule if I have to cancel?

If the cancellation occurs before September 1, we will try to reschedule the group for another time; however, due to the popularity of the program, space is extremely limited.

What if it rains or there is a threat of severe weather?

State Fair Academy takes place, regardless of rainy weather; however, feel free to give us a call at 405-948-6729 to double check before leaving if there is a threat of severe weather.
